Session	Objectives(s)
2a. Enrichment Program	Faculty will review and finalize Year 1 and Year 2 Enrichment syllabi.
2b. Speed Dating	Cohort 1 and 2 Scholars will have brief, focused one-on-one introductions with each other.
3a. Research Projects & Collaboration	Cohort 1 Scholars will refine research topics of interest, including but not limited to finding literature surrounding the topic, editing/revising literature reviews in progress, identifying potential collaborators from within NLCSD, and setting timelines and responsibilities for completion of tasks of collaborative research projects.
3b. NLCSD Orientation	Cohort 2 Scholars will learn about the community that comprises NLCSD, scholar expectations, NLCSD administrative structure and the Enrichment Program.
5a. Increasing Opportunities	Faculty and PAC will develop a set of standards for external professional development enrichment opportunities for Scholars; Faculty and PAC will be able to list a comprehensive array of external professional development enrichment opportunities.
5b. Words of Wisdom	Cohort 1 Scholars will share their experiences and strategies for success as first year doctoral students and NLCSD scholars.
6. Enrichment Program Planning & Discussion	NLCSD Faculty, PAC and Scholars will be aware of Enrichment topics, NLCSD meetings and conferences that will occur over in the next four years; NLCSD community will generate a list of topics and themes that the community will engage in through the Enrichment Program and face-to-face meetings, including technology used in educational environments and instructional settings by all children/learners/students.
