Dr. Teresa Ching, Keynote Speaker to speak on Longitudinal Outcomes in Children

Dr. Teresa Y.C. Ching is head of Rehabilitation Procedures research at the National Acoustic Laboratories in Australia. Her current research focuses on investigating the efficacy of early hearing aid fitting or cochlear implantation for populations of children with hearing loss, identifying factors influencing

outcomes, evaluation of sound detection and discrimination in infants with hearing loss or auditory neuropathy spectrum disorder using cortical measurements and parental reports, and prescription of hearing aids and electric-acoustic stimulation (bimodal fitting) for children and adults. Teresa is leading longitudinal, population-based studies that examine the outcomes of children with bilateral or unilateral hearing loss. She has published more than 120 peer-reviewed manuscripts. She serves on the editorial boards of four international journals.
