



Welcome to the 2020-21 School Year at St. Theresa School!

We know we still have the whole summer to go, but below is a quick check list for you to use to prepare for the 2020-21 school year at St. Theresa School! **All the links and forms are on the website.**

All Students

- ☐ **Bus requests must be requested by Friday, May 29 on-line**
- ☐ Order Supply Kit online by June 14, 2020 -or- purchase required school supplies by August 19 (Meet the Teacher Day)
- ☐ Make sure your Smart Tuition is set up with the correct banking accounts and active by July 1
- ☐ Order uniform from Dennis Uniform – 1st uniform day is Thursday, August 20
- ☐ Make sure SchoolRush is active and receiving text messages and notifications
- ☐ Complete medical notification forms – asthma, medication at school, etc. and return to school by August 18
- ☐ All parents need to have completed all the background check requirements to volunteer in school activities:
 - VIRTUS Training (one time only, certificate must be on file with Mrs. Zielinski)
 - CANTS – must be signed annually and returned to Mrs. Zielinski by August 18
 - Code of Conduct – must be signed annually and returned to Mrs. Zielinski by August 18
 - Background Check (one time only, online)

Items by Grade

ATTENTION KINDERGARTEN AND 6TH GRADE PARENTS!

All students must have the required immunization, physical, and other medical forms on file by Curriculum Night, Tuesday, August 18. Students may not attend school until these forms have been filed. Please be sure you have spoken with your pediatrician and made the proper appointments for your child! We understand that making appointments during COVID can be challenging! - Physical needed for first time preschoolers

Kindergarten

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18 (must be turned in, in order to start school!)
- ☐ Physical (with second booster of MMR and varicella completed)
- ☐ Dental exam completed by a Dentist
- ☐ Vision by an ophthalmologist or optometrist

2nd Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18
 - ☐ Dental exam completed by a Dentist

4th Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18
 - ☐ Sports Physical for Interscholastic Sports (only required if participating in Cross Country and/or Track)

5th Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18
 - ☐ Sports Physical for Interscholastic Sports

6th Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18 (must be turned in, in order to start school)
 - ☐ Physical with TdAP and meningococcal Immunizations
 - ☐ Dental exam completed by a Dentist

7th Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18
 - ☐ Sports Physical for Interscholastic Sports

8th Grade

- Complete Medical forms as follows and turn in to school by August 18
 - ☐ Sports Physical for Interscholastic Sports

• Safe School and Environment Training

All volunteers who have contact with students at school or at school-related activities, including class activities, lunch duty, coaching, chaperone field trips, etc. must complete VIRTUS certification and a criminal background check. Each year, all adults must also complete a DCFS CANTS form and a Code of Conduct acknowledgement form. These will be available at Preschool orientation and Curriculum Night in August.

No adult will be allowed contact with students unless s/he is in completed compliance with this policy so we encourage you to complete these steps prior to the start of school in August!
