CASA MILAGROSA

We operate Casa Milagrosa, a vital day resource center for unhoused individuals in the MacArthur Park area. Through radical hospitality daily, we provide a warm and welcoming refuge to up to 150 clients. People of color here are more likely to face homelessness, often compounded by chronic illness or mental health challenges. With scarce resources available, Casa Milagrosa offers a lifeline in the community to assist them in building lives of greater dignity and independence and transitioning to housing.

DAX HOUSE

Collegiate homelessness is a growing crisis across America – especially in Los Angeles. At Depaul USA, we believe no student should choose between getting an education and having a safe place to live. Since 2015, Depaul USA has successfully managed the Dax program, a holistic multi-pronged strategy that provides housing and support services to college students experiencing homelessness. In L.A. we provide the support to students from LATTC & USC. The program presently serves homeless and housing-insecure students in Los Angeles, Chicago, New York City, and Philadelphia.
