OFFICIAL RULES

1. Contestants: There must be at least two people, no more than four, in a group. The entry fee per group is \$150.00, which includes the crawfish.

2. Each group is responsible for setting up their own tent and must fit in the allotted space of 10x10. Tents, boiling pots, and any additional equipment must be set up on Friday, April 30th, 2021. Sponsor or group names are to be displayed clearly in front of the tent. All food supplies are to be brought the following morning, Saturday, May 1st, 2021. Water attachments will be provided at each tent site.

Security will be provided on Friday night. Due to the number of participants, no tents will be allowed to set up on Saturday morning: this is STRICTLY ENFORCED.

3. All participants must be ready to start boiling crawfish no later than 9:30 a.m. Crawfish can be served to the public beginning at 10:30 a.m. – do not serve any items prior to this time.

3. Tent placement will be determined by drawing numbers. This will take place at the ***MANDATORY MEETING* at C&R's on April 28th, 2021 at 7 p.m.** Please have one team member present to represent your group. If you do not attend, a number will be drawn for you. *Tents must be down and removed NO LATER than 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, May 1st, 2021.*

4. All cooking utensils, burners, propane, trash containers, etc. must be supplied by the individual groups. All seasoning, corn, and potatoes are also to be supplied by the cook off participants. The entry fee is inclusive of crawfish *only*.

5. C&R's will provide the paper products for serving crawfish to the public.

6. Each group will be asked to boil no less than 150lbs of crawfish, including 48 half ears of corn and approximately 10lbs of small potatoes. Any other ingredients such as garlic, mushrooms, sausage, etc. is optional and certainly welcomed!

7. Crawfish will be served to the public for a fee of \$25.00. Wrist bands will be provided to the public, please do not serve to anyone without a wrist band. Four wrist bands will be provided to each participating group so that they might sample the other crawfish. Any others in your group will be required to pay the \$25.00.

8. Teams can bring three (3) cases of beer for their personal consumption. All beer must be in cans. NO OUTSIDE LIQUOR is allowed – it can be purchased from C&R's only. Please adhere to these rules and do NOT bring in extra beer for your guests or any additional team members!

WINNERS

Judging will begin at 1 p.m. SHARP, buckets will be provided for judging. A copy of the judging rules is available upon request. The contest will end at 4:30 p.m., or when the crawfish runs out!

Entries will be judged on taste ONLY!! The decisions of our judges are final.

A panel of nine to eleven judges will be blindfolded during the tasting, and scoring will be on a scale: 1, 1.5, 2, 2.5, 3, 3.5, 4, 4.5, 5, 5.5, 6, 6.5, 7, 7.5, 8, 8.5, 9, 9.5, and 10. 10 is the highest score.

AWARDS, TROPHIES, AND PRIZES will be presented at 4:00 p.m.

- ***AWARD: "People's Choice"***
A bucket or jar will be provided to each booth for cash donations to determine the winner of the People's Choice Award. The booth with the most dollars in their bucket wins. All donations will go to The Hancock Resource Center.
- ***AWARD: "Most Interesting, Edible Lagniappe Item Included in Crawfish Boil"***
 - Ex. Pineapple, pork roast, and Brussel sprouts were some of the items found in last year's boil.
 - The item has to actually been cooked in the boil!
- ***CASH PRIZES: 1st PLACE - \$500 & 2ND PLACE - \$250***
- ***TROPHIES: To be presented to first, second, and third place winners.***
