COMMENCEMENT SEATING

Seating in the Residence Hall/Recreation Center will be on a first-come, first-served basis, with no tickets required. We encourage family members and friends of graduates to arrive early to allow ample time to park and secure seating prior to the beginning of the processional at 11:40 a.m. Doors open at 10:30 a.m. Limited special needs seating will be available. **If occupancy is reached in the Residence Hall/Recreation Center, the ceremony may be viewed via livestream in Wentz Concert Hall, 171 E. Chicago Ave.**

PHOTOGRAPHS OF GRADUATES

Arrangements have been made with GradImages for a professional photographer to capture the moment each graduate crosses the stage. Graduates will receive a passport-sized, full-color proof in the mail approximately one week after the ceremony. Commemorative North Central College Brick 2022

We invite you to commemorate your North Central graduate, family member, or friend by purchasing a personalized brick! This year, we are excited to offer four brick locations.

- 1. Old Main Plaza:** the Plaza lies just north of Old Main near the Boilerhouse Café.
- 2. Bambule Riverwalk Gateway:** located on the south end of campus just northwest of Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium, connecting the campus with Downtown Naperville.
- 3. Dr. Myron Wentz Science Center:** the entryway connects the northern and southern ends of campus.
- 4. WONC-FM 89.1:** on the campus walkway located on the eastside of the WONC house.

Bricks cost \$250. All bricks can have up to three lines of text engraved with 15 characters (spaces included) per line. Text is centered and in all caps. All efforts will be made for brick installation to take place as soon as possible. To guarantee installation by Homecoming 2022 orders must be placed by **June 1**.
