Fees

OPCC is the EarlyON Child and Family Centre for the Oakville community, and fees are not charged for these programs. For programs that have a fee, payment is due upon registration.

Withdrawals & Refunds

A \$25.00 administration fee is charged for all refund and change requests. Refunds & changes are only available if requested 5 business days before program starts. No refunds or changes are possible after program begins. This excludes licensed programs. Contact our main location for assistance with refunds and changes.
