



Dear Families,

We are so excited to start this year as a newly unified religious school with your children. Senior Rabbi Daniel Fellman and Rabbi Larry Freedman, together with Cantor David Reinwald and Rabbi Stephanie Wolfe (Assistant Director J-JEP), Senior Rabbi Seth Adelson (Beth Shalom), and Associate Rabbi Mark Goodman (Beth Shalom), have been working together over the past several months to create a new religious school program — a program which builds on the strengths of our two religious schools — J-JEP (joint Rodef Shalom/Beth Shalom religious school) and Temple Sinai's NextDOR — as well as our collective aspirations for a vibrant, engaged, and unified religious school.

There will be some new curricula options—and one new tradition to enjoy on Sunday mornings, which is J-JEP's tradition of serving bagels, juice, and coffee from 8:15–9:45 AM each Sunday morning.

Hebrew for this first year of unification will have three Hebrew programs for 3-6th graders.

- **Family Hebrew:** This is the most popular program. 8:30–9:30 AM before Judaics. A parent (or other adult) sits with the student and you learn together. It moves quickly with parents acting as coaches or learning as well. Childcare for younger siblings is provided.
- **Wednesday afternoon:** 4:30–6:30 PM. This option will return to the building at Fifth & Morewood. We have tefillah for the first half hour which lets us discuss the meaning and usefulness of prayer. Then class for 90 minutes with snack break. This is a little more leisurely, allowing for a variety of activities.
- **Sunday after Judaics:** This is a 60-minute class following Judaics Sunday morning occurring from 12:00–1:00 PM. A small snack will be provided.
