

Coaching for CyberPatriot and StellarXplorers Coaches

Coaching a CyberPatriot or StellarXplorers team, or doing so for the first time? CAP Cyber has an opportunity to help you kick start your program. Although this is intended for new coaches, any coach or prospective coach is welcome – this is a great way to learn about the program. Maj. William Blatchley, Civil Air Patrol National Headquarters' Cyber Mission Team deputy for education and awareness, is hosting bi-weekly coaches' meetings to help get you started, beginning from Aug. 7 for the StellarXplorers meeting and Aug. 14 for CyberPatriot.

StellarXplorers meetings will be on the first and third Thursday of each month. CyberPatriot will be on the second and fourth Thursdays of the month. The intent of each of these training opportunities is to introduce new or prospective team coaches to the software and concepts behind each of these Air and Space Forces Association nationwide STEM competitions.

Blatchley will discuss the software required (which is provided free) for each of the competitions and how to use that software, as well as team strategy and what it takes to form a new team including the registration process.

The meetings will be at 9 p.m. Eastern Time, 6 p.m. Pacific Time via Microsoft Teams. All training sessions will be recorded so that they can be viewed at a later time if you miss a training session, or want to review it and will be located at [this link](#).
