

Biscuit Run Park Walk

Biscuit Run Park, one of the most highly anticipated recreational venues in the history of our area parks system, won't officially be open to the public until the fall of 2023 but an early morning guided walk on Sunday July 10th will give anyone, who wants to explore this majestic park, an up-close sneak preview of the County's newest greenspace gem.

Led by the Piedmont Environmental Council's (PEC) energetic community advocate Peter Krebs and hosted by the Ragged Mountain Running and Walking Shop, this guided walking tour will give folks a rare opportunity to explore, on foot, portions of Albemarle County's newest park. At a mind-boggling 1200 acres, this sprawling park, located just south of the city off Old Lynchburg Road, once opened, will be the County's largest of its many beautiful parks.
