



NOTICE TO CANDIDATES FOR THE 2017 MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL GENERAL ELECTION

On May 11, 2017 the Returning Officer will be hosting a Candidate Information Session for all potential candidates. The session will be from **6:30 to 8:30 p.m. in Progress Hall (5 St. Anne Street, St. Albert, Alberta)** and is open to candidates, the media, and anyone who has an interest in the 2017 election process.

A second Candidate Information Session is tentatively scheduled for late August 2017. This session will only be held if new information needs to be shared with potential candidates or potential candidates advise the Returning Officer of a need for a second session.

The Candidate Information Session will provide candidates with preliminary information about the role of Mayor and Council, remuneration, time commitment, campaign signage, nominations, financial disclosure requirements, the need to register prior to accepting campaign donations, etc.

Potential candidates will be able to obtain information from the Election Office starting on May 4, 2017 by visiting the City's election website page (stalbert.ca/election) or obtaining hard copy Candidate Information Packages starting May 11, 2017 from the 3rd Floor of St. Albert Place.

Potential candidates are encouraged to visit the City's election website often as we move towards Election Day for updated information and to review the names of those who have submitted their Notice of Intent form.
