Responsibilities

- Prayerfully listen to where God is leading us in worship.
- Lead, manage, and administrate all aspects of traditional worship.
- Work with pastors and Contemporary Worship Leader to plan thematically worship services.
- Choose hymns, special music, and choral anthems that support thematic worship and engages participation.
- In collaboration with our pastors and staff, put out schedules at least one month in advance.
- Work as part of a team to plan, and/or participate in special worship services (I.E. Advent, Christmas Eve, Lent mid-week worship, etc.)
- Organize and conduct choir.
