LIFE LESSON
A focus on social-emotional learning is critical to our program and supported through literacy and related experiences. This week we are reading *Elmer the Patchwork Elephant* by David McKee to support the development of self-awareness, which helps children acknowledging their strengths as well as their classmates' strengths.

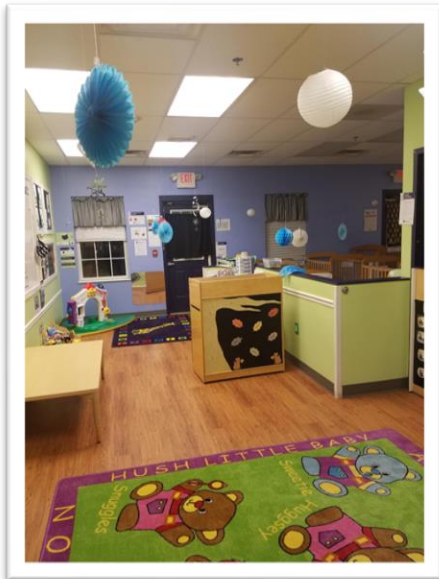
- ✈ Forming and maintaining a secure attachment to a parent or caregiver.

- 🐘 Expressing early language, creativity and emotions in encouraging ways.



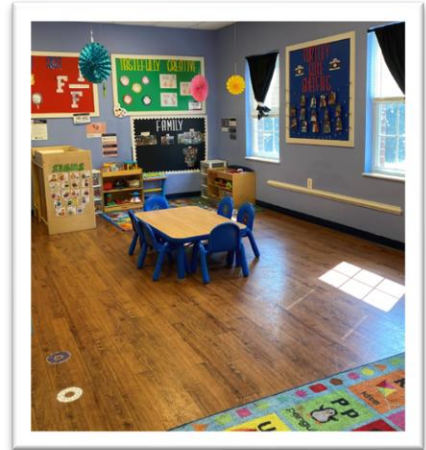

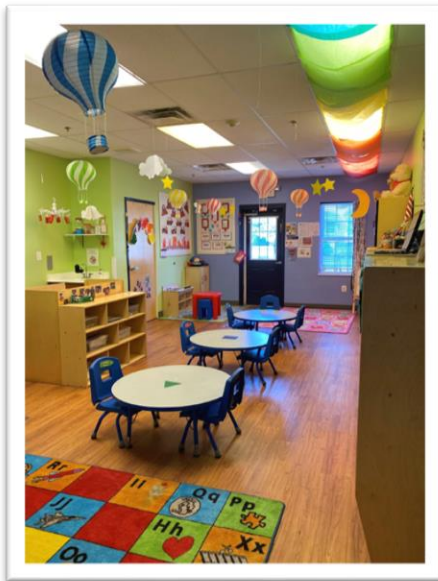

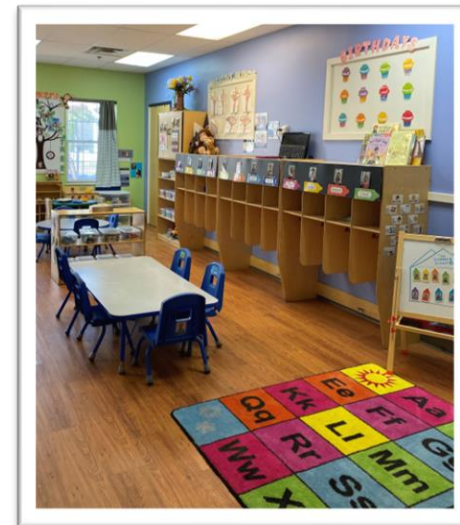

The fun and excitement of learning through exploration continues in our get set classroom, where little ones begin to transition to preschool routines and new conventions of play. Your child will learn skills like:

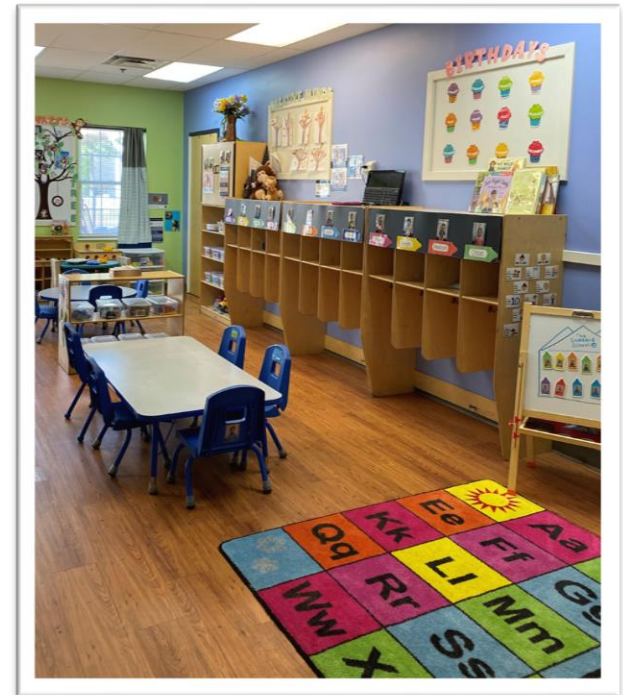
- 🐼 Grasping tools and utensils with intention to make more precise lines or scribbles.

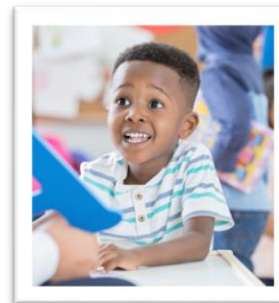

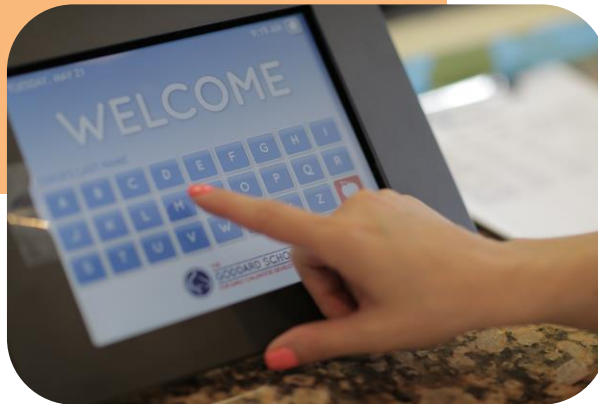
