What will happen when I arrive at the synagogue?

What do I need to do to attend services?

You will stand outside on one of the indicated spots to maintain social distancing while you wait to enter the building. You will then be asked to review a symptom checklist and your temperature will be taken. You will also be asked to sanitize your hands before entering the building, and to put on a mask if you are not already wearing one.

Must I wear a mask?

Thursday.

Yes. Everyone entering Shir Chadash must wear an appropriate mask or face covering, covering both mouth and nose, while in the building.

What if I need a break from wearing my mask?

You should step outside if you need to remove your mask for a few minutes.

What if I don't have an appropriate mask or I forget to bring one with me?

As you enter the building, a greeter will give you a single-use disposable mask. Please place it in the trash receptacle by the door when you leave the building.

What if I or someone in my party is medically unable to wear a mask or face covering?

Please send an email with the specifics in advance to our Executive Director (execdir@shirchadash.org).

Is social distancing required at all times?

Yes. Individuals who are not members of the same household should maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from others. Please do not congregate in the hallways, bathrooms, foyer, or parking lot.

Where will services take place?

Services will be held in the Sanctuary to best accommodate the need for social distancing. In addition, whenever possible, windows and doors will be opened to maximize ventilation.

What will social distancing look like in the Sanctuary?

Some rows in the Sanctuary will be blocked off and the areas designated for seating will be clearly marked. Only members of the same household may sit together. Extended family members who interact regularly can be considered part of the same household.

May I bring my children?

Yes. Children under age 13 are welcome as long as they are able to stay seated with their families in the Sanctuary for the duration of the services. They will be asked to sit with members of their household only.

May our out-of-town guests attend?

Regretfully, we cannot accommodate out-of-town guests, but they are welcome to join us for services online.

What about books? *kippot*? *tallitot*?

We encourage everyone to bring their own prayer books, *kippot*, and *tallitot*. If you need a *kippah*, one will be available when you enter the building. If you do not have your own prayer books, they will be available. Please do not share books. As you exit, please leave the books on your seat, and place your borrowed *kippot* in the designated receptacle.

How long will services be?

Abbreviated services will be conducted and will last no more than two hours.

What about aliyot?

Rabbi Silver will call the *aliyot*. Those taking an *aliyah* may choose to do so either from their seat or come up to the *bimah* and stand directly in front of the Ark, facing out. Please return to your seat after taking an *aliyah*.

What about other honors?

The prayers for the community and the country will be offered to attendees as usual or recited in unison. Readers will recite the prayers from their seats.
