WHAT IS A SENIOR LEVY?

A senior levy is a property tax authorized by Missouri state law to **BENEFIT** older residents.

The funding comes from a property tax of five cents per \$100 of assessed value on both real and personal property. Funds will support services enabling individuals to age in place in Jackson County. This includes services like HOME-DELIVERED MEALS, SENIOR CENTERS AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, **HOME-SAFETY REPAIR, TRANSPORTATION**, and supports for daily living for older adults.

HOW WOULD A SENIOR LEVY HELP?

- Generate \$8M \$10M annually to support senior services.
- ALL funds will stay in Jackson County.
- Like 55 other counties in MO, the Jackson County senior levy will be governed by an independent citizen board to benefit the local aging community.
