San Francisco Fire Department 129th Class of Entry-Level Firefighters to be Sworn In

San Francisco, CA – San Francisco Fire Department Graduates 42 Entry-Level Firefighters and 5 Firefighter-Paramedics.

On Friday, June 3rd, 2022, Fire Chief Jeanine Nicholson will be administering the Oath of Allegiance to 47 Entry-Level Firefighters. 5 of the 47 are Firefighter Paramedics, and 1 is an EMT from the Department's EMS Division and will be enhancing our Engine-based Paramedic services.

"This group of probationary firefighters has completed a rigorous 20-week Fire Academy," said Chief Nicholson. "Within the next several days, all will report to their new station assignments, marking the beginning of their year-long probationary period."

The 129th Academy is a diverse group of individuals, including a military veteran (1) from the United States Air Force, EMTs, Paramedics, Firefighters from other jurisdictions, a Horse trainer, several people in the trades, and a Nurse.

This ceremony represents the next step forward in a rewarding public safety career for these graduates.
