San Francisco Fire Department Extinguishes 2-Alarm Home Fire

SAN FRANCISCO, CA- A home fire quickly grew to a 2-alarm fire as it spread to an adjacent home, displacing 4.

On 01-05-2024, at 4:19 PM, the San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) responded to a reported structure fire at 109 Lowell Street, a two-story, detached single-family home. SFFD arrived on scene at 4:22 PM and declared this a working fire, with smoke and flames visible on the first and second floors and flames extending to an adjoining 3-story multi-family dwelling at 691 Morse Street. At 4:29, this fire was declared a 2-alarm fire, bringing a total of 74 firefighters and Paramedic staff to the scene.

The damage from this fire was limited to 109 Lowell Street and exterior damage to 691 Morse Street with no injuries and 4 displaced due in part to the firefighters that quickly stretched handlines to extinguish fire on both floors while protecting the adjoining buildings (exposures).

This fire was contained at 5:00 PM and remains under investigation.
