## SFFD Super Bowl LVIII Preparations

**San Francisco, CA** – In preparation for the San Francisco 49er's appearance in Super Bowl LVIII on Sunday, February 11, 2024, the San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) is working with our local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies and partner city agencies to ensure public safety. The SFFD is adequately staffed to respond to all emergency calls for service citywide. We are prepositioning additional resources and working with our Public Safety Partners to respond with those resources to emergencies if they arise.

If you are traveling to friends or a public location, please consider using public transportation. If you must drive, plan a designated driver and a meeting point in case of separation, and remember food, water, and clothes for hot or cold weather. If you take medications, bring extra in case you are delayed getting home.

If you celebrate at home, ensure you have working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. Have an emergency exit plan, post it, share it, and practice it. Do not use open flames without a permit. If at a location with heaters, candles, or open flame sources, keep at least three feet away, and keep all combustibles at least three feet away. Make sure elevated windows are secure. Ensure balconies and decks are safe and can handle the number of visitors you intend to have on them.

The use of Fireworks in San Francisco is prohibited. They are prohibited because they cause death, injury, and property damage. If you see someone using fireworks, call 311 and provide the location, address, and description of those using them. You can do this anonymously.

If you See Something, Say Something. If you see something suspicious, or someone requiring medical or behavior assistance, or observe an activity that can lead to injury or property damage, call 911. For all other situations in San Francisco, call 311. Together, we are a stronger and safer San Francisco.

We want to remind everyone who plans to participate in Super Bowl festivities to have fun and do so safely, respectfully, and responsibly. This is your home and your team; let's show the world how respectful we are to one another, no matter the outcome.
