San Francisco Fire Department 128th Class of Entry-Level Firefighters to be Sworn In

San Francisco, CA – San Francisco Fire Department Graduates 35 Entry-Level Firefighters

On Thursday, December 23rd, 2021, Fire Chief Jeanine Nicholson will be administering the Oath of Allegiance to 35 Entry-Level Firefighters. Six (6) of the 35 are Firefighter Paramedics from the Department's EMS Division and will be enhancing our Engine-based Paramedic services.

"This group of probationary firefighters have completed a rigorous 20-week Fire Academy," said Chief Nicholson. "Within the next several days, all will report to their new station assignments, marking the beginning of their year-long probationary period."

The 128th Academy is a diverse group of individuals that include military veterans (2) from the United States Army and USMC, a Nanny, professional athletes (Basketball), EMTs, Paramedics, and Firefighters from other jurisdictions, a Lifeguard, several people in the trades, and a barista. Two of our new Firefighters welcomed a new child into their lives during this academy as well.

This ceremony represents the next step forward in a rewarding public safety career for these graduates.
