## San Francisco Fire to host a commemoration of fallen EMS heroes

**San Francisco, CA** – The [National EMS Memorial Bike Ride](#), Inc. honors EMS personnel by organizing and implementing long-distance cycling events that memorialize and celebrate the lives of those who serve every day, those who have become sick or injured while performing their duties, and those who have died in the line of duty.
