San Francisco Fire to host a commemoration of fallen EMS heroes

San Francisco, CA – The [National EMS Memorial Bike Ride](#), Inc. honors EMS personnel by organizing and implementing long-distance cycling events that memorialize and celebrate the lives of those who serve every day, those who have become sick or injured while performing their duties, and those who have died in the line of duty. This year, the West Coast Chapter is riding from Sacramento to San Francisco carrying dog tags for fallen SFFD Firefighter Paramedic [Jason Cortez](#), who died in the line of duty, and King America 911 Ambulance Paramedic [Gabe Salvador](#), who died after battling cancer.

The team will ride across the Golden Gate Bridge at 3:15 p.m. and conclude their journey at the Warming Hut. A celebration including Honor Guards, the singing of Amazing Grace, and Bag Pipes are planned.
