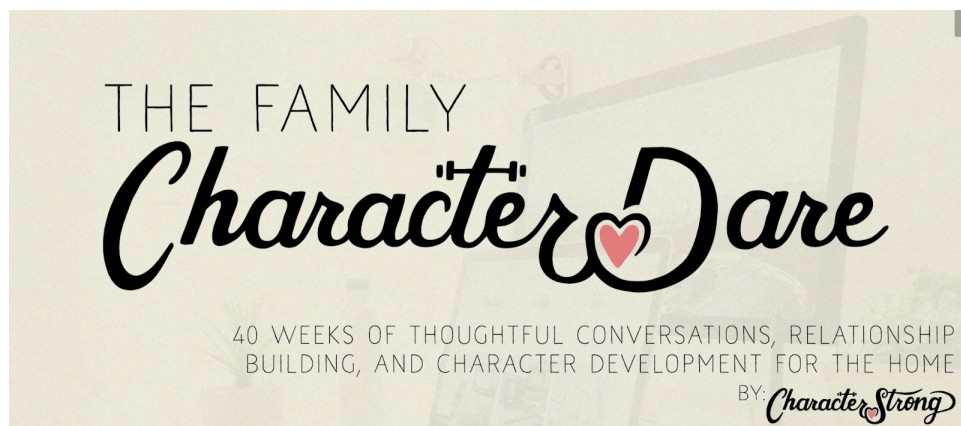

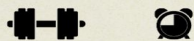
Week 1- Character Dare
