ZOOM Update (from the CNG Technology Department)

- All students at CNG do not have a Zoom account in the CNG domain. Their Zoom account is either their own or a parent's Zoom account.
- As a K-12 school, we are gradually moving towards every student having a Zoom account in the CNG domain which will ultimately ensure safe video conferencing for teachers and students. Elementary students will be receiving their own Zoom accounts following the high school and middle school students so we can conduct adequate testing to ensure product reliability with our older students.
- Since students are using their own Zoom account, they will be subject to emails sent by Zoom to highlight program features, updates, and other Zoom information. We are confirming with Zoom, but we do not believe Zoom distributes client information for the purpose of marketing.
