Important Reminders:

- **8th Moving Up Ceremony** - students should dress up appropriately.
- **Electronics/Social Media**- Please continue to be vigilant against people trying to “follow” or contact your kids through social media. Consider a nightly “turn in” time where kids hand over their devices and know that you may review any messages or sites. Technically the devices are owned by us, the adults and can be respectfully checked like other items in our home.
- **Advisory**- Advisories have been selected for next year. Some students will be staying with the same teacher, or the same group with a different teacher, or completely new. These lists were intentionally created to ensure cohesion going into next school year. Advisory will be structured differently next year- students will have time to team-build, work on social service, have opportunity day time during the day and participate in grade-level and interest based meetings. NEW- Advisories will be connected to CWW. This will allow for groups to plan, collaborate and work together on the trip. Students will still be able to request a friend on the trip- and we will do our best to combine Advisories to accommodate everyone having at least one close friend on the trip.
- **Course requests and Schedules**- Your child will get their COURSE REQUEST LIST next week. This is all the classes that they will be signed up for- not by period or teacher. They will receive their SCHEDULE- with teacher names, rooms and periods the week prior to school starting.
- **Supplies**- We will include a SHORT supplies list for next year along with your child’s course requests and Advisor. We suggest only getting the minimum supplies and plan on purchasing what the teacher requests when school begins. We will ensure any supplies needed after school begins can be locally sourced.
- **Returning Materials**
 - Books FROM SOCIALES, ESPANOL AND ENGLISH CLASSES ONLY- When you are safely able, we would like any borrowed materials return for our planning purposes. When you are safely able to return those items, they will need to be labeled- BY CLASS, TEACHER and STUDENT NAME, please and dropped at the CNG Porteria.

- CNG library is not requesting books from returning staff or returning students, Currently we have set up a Drop box at the CNG main gate to collect only library books and classroom textbooks assigned under the library accounts from Withdrawn families, and non returning staff.
- Band Instruments and Materials- Students who are withdrawing and have CNG instruments at home, please return them to the Main Gate (portaria) before you leave the country with the following information: Student name, grade, and teacher name. Please contact your teacher to confirm the instrument return.
