- **Entrance and ID Cards:** Students will be able to enter on Monday Nov. 9th and receive their ID cards in the first block of class. Please see this [presentation](#) for more information on entry and exit. Please note, Middle School students must be dropped off on Cra 4 Este (Top of the hill). No MS students should be dropped off in front of the school.
- Plan for 8:30AM Daily Check ins- Students will have daily check ins. If you are unable to make the check ins, students should let Advisors know. The purpose of the daily check ins are to provide student support during Hybrid, to get in a “back to school mindset” and to continue staying connected
- Review Hybrid Orientation materials in the MS Family Portal as needed.
- Remember, Middle School will be PHONE FREE beginning 11/9. Students may have phones turned off and in their backpacks (if they need them) on campus

This week:

-Write down all your teachers and meeting times or take a screenshot- you may use the "f"function to search your child's name to get a list of all your sign ups.


-Please be careful not to override any time slot- please don't put your name on anyone else's name. Only sign up in blank spaces- black areas are teacher breaks- please work around those times.
