Thank you to the 75+ people who joined Coffee Chat on Thursday! Summary of the discussion...

- Hybrid Model and return to school? We shared what we know:
 - Health/safety is first priority
 - The following was sent through the Parent Council members' chat to each grade level group:
"Please remember that we are working on tentative drafts and options for the hybrid model. In this work we are in continued conversations with CNG Leadership, Dr Habegger, and the CNG Board. Dr. Habegger will release official communication as decisions are made."
- PPT presentation (featuring subtitle translation in Spanish!) from Lisa, Adri and Moni about CloseGap (grades 3 and 4) and a Universal Screener (grade 5) addressing students' social-emotional well-being. The presentation was sent via Skyward to families on Friday, 9/11, and here is the link: [Well Being Presentation](#)
- Bridges Math Curriculum Delivery update: materials were delivered to families in the Bogota area. Those students out of town/country will have access to the materials via PDF's posted on the HR teachers' Google Classrooms.
- MAP Testing: We will administer MAP. HS and MS are doing it online and we will make our test scheduling decisions after we receive feedback from their experience. We would all prefer in-person but that may not be possible.
- Are Counseling lessons optional in DL? No, they are part of the ES curriculum and provide a great environment for students to participate and share experiences.
- There were lots of virtual hugs and positive comments about the work we are all doing – in partnership – to support our children in Distance Learning!
