Last Week's Coffee Chat Highlights: We presented the Elementary School Hybrid Model PPT at the Coffee Chat. ES will be using a Partner Teacher Model. All students will remain with their own HR teacher, whether virtually or in person. The HR teacher will have a Partner Teacher who will support the students. The individuals taking those roles include TA's, Instructional Coaches, and some Specialists. There were a lot of questions about masks and the criteria around masks. REMINDER: MAP testing for 4th/5th Grade

NWEA's MAP Growth test is an adaptive test to measure a child's skill level in Math, Reading and Language (in 3 individual tests for each subject). It provides the teachers with immediate, accurate information about a student's learning. The 4th graders will be testing on Oct. 14, 15 and 16 and 5th graders on Oct. 20, 21 and 22. The make up testing will be on Oct. 23rd. Please watch your parent emails for more specific information about device system requirements and specific times of the day for each test for your child.
