It's time to take this year's yearbook picture!

For the 2021 Andean, we are changing up our pictures to reflect our reality. As we all know, this year's circumstances are unlike anything we have lived before and as a school we must adapt to the changes. This is why, instead of taking the usual group pictures for the Primary and Elementary sections of our Andean, we will be creating an Andean of SELFIES. Every student in PS and ES must send in a selfie to be included in the Andean and we need YOUR HELP as parents to make it happen.


- Have fun with the pictures! Students don't have to be in uniform and the background is up to each student or parent.
- All pictures should align with the CNG code of honor.
- All pictures **must be selfies**, that is to say, a picture taken by each student of themselves. **For younger students, parents can take the picture or help their children take it.**



- Selfies should show the student's entire face, head, and shoulders. No full body pictures will be allowed and no cropped faces or heads can be included.



- Please, **hold the phone vertically** to take the selfie or picture, no horizontal pictures will be accepted.



- Student's faces should be clearly visible in the picture. Make sure they aren't covering their faces with accessories, their hands, hats, masks, shadows, etc.




- Only pictures in COLOR will be accepted. Please make sure nobody sends a black & white picture or a heavily filtered photograph.



- No hand gestures or signs.



- Tell your children they can smile, laugh, raise an eyebrow, or even wink; but they shouldn't close both their eyes, stick out their tongue, frown, puff their cheeks, roll their eyes, or pull a duck face. Basically, have fun, but make sure everyone's easily recognizable.



Once you have a picture you and your child are all happy with, please send it to your child's Homeroom Teacher via email. Avoid using whatsapp or other types of social media to send the pictures as this would lower the quality of the pictures and they might look blurry when we print them.



Keep in mind that the picture file should be saved as your child's name and their class number (ex: Amaya Gómez E5), help out our teachers by saving it like that from the start!
