

Ongoing Reminders:

- School supplies from last year will be delivered this week to students on campus. Please note that if your children Opted Out and you want to pick up your children supplies from last year, you must contact the ms office and schedule a time to pick them up during the next 2 weeks. If you want to donate those materials to CFNG please send us an email notifying the office. All not reported material will be donated automatically.
- T-shirt info- or those families that Opted Out, we kindly request you to please pass by the school during the next 2 weeks to pick up your child T-shirt at the



main gate. Please make sure you notify ms dismissal@cng.edu before going. If you are away from CNG, don't worry- we will keep your t-shirt until you arrive. Look for special t-shirt days where we all wear our t-shirts at home and on campus. In the meantime, t-shirts and custom sweatshirts may be worn as part of the daily uniform.

- Students will need their access card next week to enter campus. Please make sure they have it daily. If they need a replacement (25mil), please contact ms.dismissal@cng.edu
- Please remind our students to keep 2 meter distance from others at school, you must be with a teacher at all times, please report to campus no earlier than 10:45 with our new start time at 11AM.
- No cellphones in middle school- when a student arrives, they will turn <u>their</u> <u>phone off and put it in their backpack.</u> Consequences for visible cell phones in middle school are:
 - -First offense- warning.
 - Second offense, the phone is taken away and will be returned to the student at the end of the day. Parents are notified. PLEASE NOTE, WE WILL BEGIN THIS IN MODULE 3.
 - Third offense: Phone is taken away and must be picked up by a parent from an administrator at the end of the day
- OODC is 3mil- no change given- however, pay what you would like- all donations are appreciated. If you have already paid for the year, no need to pay again on campus. Only CNG approved masks are allowed. Please review the figure to the right with your child- midriff areas must be covered.
