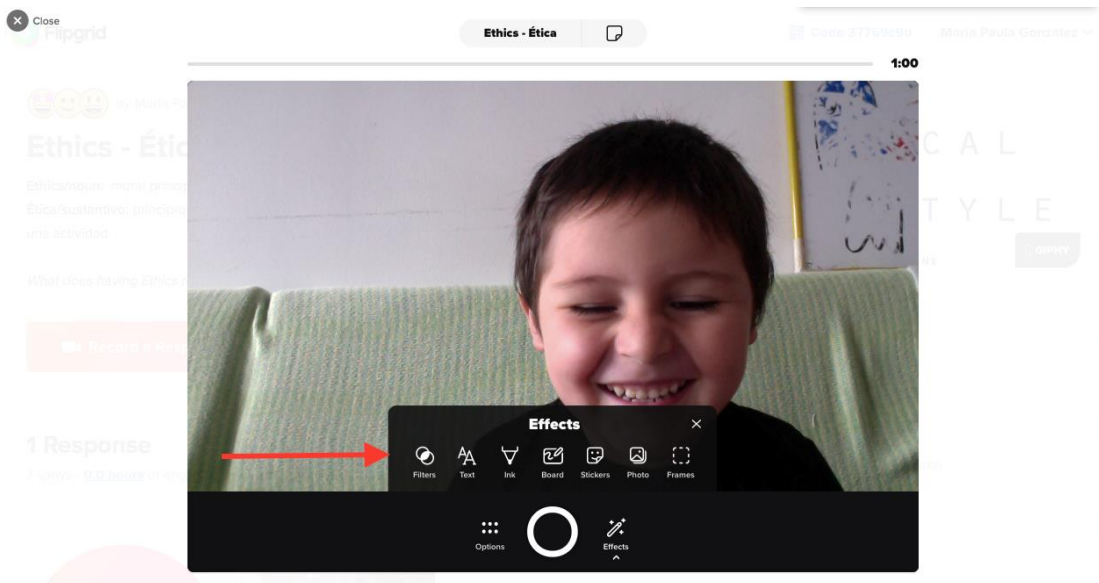

- All-In Pilot: feedback about virtual homeroom model. We are having a meeting with the three virtual teachers to talk about what we can improve.
- First Communions: will reach out to Sonia for more communication on 3rd grade First Communion. Right now, waiting for Religion Dept. to meet and set a new date for 4th grade First Communion as well; might have to be during the week.
- We will be working with our students on potential Academic Gaps: examining MAP data, Running Records, Math assessments, etc; as well as talking about possible social-emotional concerns. Discussing, “leveling-Up,” going into the 2021-22 school year.
- Seth Jaeger and our Gifted & Talented team are going through COGAT exam results in order to invite those students who qualify to join the IDEA Program.
- Placements: Working on a system with HR teachers and PS (future 3rd graders) in order to have balanced classes regarding academic abilities, behaviors, and other pertinent characteristics.
