School & Home School Field Trips:



Fall Curriculums Available:



Make your Bonfire Site Reservation: Private bonfire sites are available to rent with at least 24 hours advance notice. Each bonfire site includes two wooden benches, one picnic table, one serving table and a trash receptacle. Guests may bring additional seating if they wish. Guests also need to provide their own roasting sticks and may bring food items they wish to roast.

Rental is \$25.00 per site for a three-hour time increment. Times available are: 10am - 1pm, 1pm - 4pm or 4pm - 6pm Mondays-Saturdays AND 11am-2pm, 2pm-5pm and 5pm - close on Sundays. Due to the popularity of the bonfire sites, we advise booking a site WELL in advance of your function. Call us at 319-470-1558 to make your reservation today!

Our Commitment to our Guests – Our Covid-19 Safety Plan

We would like all of our guests to know that we take the safety of our staff, customers and families very seriously. For the past 10+ years, we have taken great pride in creating and implementing an "Employee and Guests Safety/Crisis Plan" in order to ensure the safety of everyone that visits and works on our farm. Our safety plan is also reviewed on a yearly basis by our local health department, emergency management authorities - police, fire, ambulance - and the Emergency Management Coordinator of Lee County. We strive to always continue to be a leader in practices of farm safety, sanitation and hygiene with all of our staff, as well as our guests.

Throughout the challenging year last year of COVID-19, we took our safety practices further through the implementation of more in-depth sanitation practices throughout our farm, advanced hygiene education and training for our staff, maintaining a close connection with our local health department and staying informed and following up-to-date state and federal guidelines. We want our guests to know those implementations are here to stay.

Our Commitments to Our Guests as an Agritourism Destination:

- Conduct safe sanitation procedures and use safe, healthy hygiene practices
- Provide proper sanitizing materials for cleaning common use surfaces and high touch surfaces as often as possible
- Make Hand sanitizing stations and hand washing sinks available to all guests and employees throughout the farm
- Train our employees on procedures related to COVID-19 to ensure safety of themselves and our guests
- Require all our employees to wear masks - per state and county guidelines
- Daily health screening of each employee working at the farm prior to each shift

We Kindly Ask Our Guests To:

- Keep other guests and our staff safe by staying home if you have been exposed to COVID-19 recently or have symptoms of COVID-19 - including a fever, cough, or shortness of breath
