



## FREE TICKETS FOR UMD STUDENTS!

### WHAT?!

All students at the University of Maryland, College Park, receive one free ticket per event! Eligible events include performances at The Clarice and MilkBoy ArtHouse that are presented by the Artist Partner Program, Michelle Smith Performing Arts Library, UMD School of Music and UMD School of Theatre, Dance, and Performance Studies.

### HOW:

1. Create an online account at [theclarice.umd.edu](http://theclarice.umd.edu). Be sure to enter your graduation year and “purchase” a Free Student Ticket registration.
2. On the first day of classes, tickets for all performances in the fall semester will become available starting at 12:00 Noon.
3. Snag a UMD Student ticket for as many shows as you’d like! You can go online, give us a call, or come to the ticket office in person.

### REMEMBER...

- You can see as many different music, theatre, and dance performances as you want, but just one performance per run. Want to see it again? Additional student tickets are just \$10!
- **Don’t ghost us!** If you have a ticket you can’t use, please give us a call (301.405.2787) or email us ([tickets-theclarice@umd.edu](mailto:tickets-theclarice@umd.edu)) and let us know at least an hour before the show starts. If your account has 3 or more unused tickets, we’ll return your remaining tickets for the semester and you’ll have to re-register next semester.
- Tickets are available on a first come, first served basis while supplies last.
