## The Basics

- Our average stipend is \$500, which is negotiable project by project.
- We run a small ship the SM runs the boards themselves during a show but we try to be as accommodating as possible, providing ample opportunity for personal growth, joy, and expression during the run of a project.
- Rehearsals are scheduled according to team availability, generally 2-3 rehearsals for 3
  hours on weekday evenings, and 1-2 rehearsals of 3-5 hours on weekends (depending
  on availability).
- The average show will have 90-100 hours of rehearsal before we open (hence the long rehearsal periods).
- We run 16 20 performances, depending on artist availability, requirements of the show, and audience demand.
- Our shows are Helen Hayes-eligible (Nu Sass has seen two nominations in the past 3 years, so it's not impossible!)

We are aware the stipend does not match the time commitment. We are a slowly growing theatre, and we're proud to have more than doubled our average stipend, but we know there is still much more growing to do. Please do not take the request as an insult. I would be foolish to not at least ask.
