



The Delaware City Schools are proud to host the Ohio Optometric Association on February 27 and 28, 2019. Both the Delaware City Schools and the Ohio Optometric Association believe that no child should be hindered in their education by the inability to see. 80% of learning is through the visual system. Unfortunately, 50% of students who do not pass the school vision screening do not get the recommended follow up exam.

The Ohio Optometric Foundation has developed the In School Eye Exam program (iSee) to bridge the gap by bringing the eye examination and eyewear directly to the students. All vision care services and glasses will be provided free of charge to students in Delaware City Schools who do not have insurance coverage for glasses. Students that are at the most risk (failed a school screening and have some financial need) will be given priority. Parents must sign a consent form for care prior to their student being scheduled. The students will be scheduled for an exam by the school nurse, and transported to the Willis Education Center on the days of the program.
