Message from Thack

Many Episcopalians know that sacraments are an important part of our spiritual lives. As it says in our Catechism, "Sacraments are outward and visible signs of inward and spiritual grace, given by Christ as sure and certain means by which we receive that grace" (p. 857, *BCP*). In the church, we have two dominical (ordained by Christ) sacraments: Baptism and Holy Eucharist, and five ecclesial sacramental rites: Marriage, Unction, Reconciliation of a Penitent, Confirmation and Ordination.

We encounter God through the sacraments and sacramental rites of the church. God also meets us through God's creation, through other persons, and most tangibly through the word made flesh in Jesus. So there is no end to how we encounter God. I call those encounters that are not sacraments of the church "sacramental moments."

I had many sacramental moments during the Cursillo retreat at Camp Beckwith last weekend. One in particular was Phyllis Cheney. Phyllis and her husband Mike are retired and live in Fort Walton Beach. Until recently, Phyllis worked part time as a math tutor for students in the local school system. She had to give that up when she was diagnosed with Stage 4 pancreatic cancer. As you might imagine, her prognosis is grim. This was evident by the pallor of her skin and her increasing weakness. She is barely ambulatory and requires a wheel chair.

Staff members who attend her church at Saint Simons' on the Sound in Fort Walton Beach told us about her condition before the weekend. When asked if she was physically up for the experience she said it was important for her to attend the retreat. So we on staff we made every effort to accommodate her needs. That said, Phyllis and Mike handled the experience quite well and required little special attention.

When I first met Phyllis last Thursday night, she greeted me with a huge smile and said she was excited to be there and looking forward to the experience. Phyllis fully engaged every activity, whether it was worship, fellowship, listening to witness talks, table discussions and just having fun. Like all of us present, Phyllis experienced the whole range of emotions. The most notable was her joy. Rarely did I see her not laughing. Whenever I asked her how she was doing, her response was always, "I'm so blessed!" She has incredible faith even in adversity.

At the closing service on Sunday Phyllis told me that she had a wonderful time and had many close moments with Christ. What she didn't know is that the rest of us did too through her. She may have been blessed but she was also a blessing to the Cursillo staff and pilgrims. Phyllis was a living outward and visible sign of inward and spiritual grace. She was my biggest sacramental moment. I'm convinced she was sent to us last weekend and together we experienced the Kingdom of God.

Tracts Talk! Ten Ways to Pray

Often when we pray, our language becomes stilted, and it may seem a bit false. Sometimes we may think we have to be in a certain place or position to pray effectively. God hears us no matter what! That said, maybe some structured prayer techniques can get us into the habit, and then, over time and with practice, we can pray more naturally and more often.

Ten ideas are presented in this pamphlet, including praying with scripture, journaling, the Daily Office, and singing, among others. Let's examine some of these.

Regarding journaling, a couple of nice books come to mind: ***The Everyday Psalmist***, a rich journal based on the Psalms. It is a guided journal that doesn't require daily entries, but if you happen to be in the mood for that type of prayer on a given day, it is beautiful, and it helps you become mindful of your prayer. This book incorporates praying with scripture as well as journaling. One of its beauties is that it gives you leave to be thankful, pleading, angry, and assured that God is always there. Another helpful book — even if you're not artistic — is ***Praying in Color*** by Sybil MacBeth. This helps you to lose the stilted language and draw or doodle what and while you're praying.

We at St. Paul's are blessed to have the Daily Office live-streamed on Facebook by Thack, in the form of Morning Prayer Monday - Saturday at 8:05. That will certainly get your prayer juices flowing. And since it's live-streamed, you can watch at your convenience. Maybe you can view it and de-stress at lunchtime.

In Thessalonians, Paul advises us to "pray without ceasing." A good friend once gave me a beautiful hand-made wooden bowl along with a deck of cards that have the inscription "Pray Without Ceasing" on one side, and space to write a prayer or request on the other. That has been a blessing, as it reminds me daily to pray without ceasing. You can create your own reminder: Get a container that you like — it can be a dish, a bowl, an attractive box, anything, really — and some index cards (colored ones if you're like me). Put them in a spot where you will see them every day, and use them as reminder to keep on prayin'.

St. Augustine said, "He who sings prays twice." How fortunate we are at St. Paul's to have such a robust music program. With John leading our melodious choir and Christopher blessing us with the organ, piano and violin, it's hard not to leave church humming a tune. Alabama Cursillo and the Diocese of Alabama publish ***Alleluia III*** songbook used at Beckwith. It is a wonderful amalgam of traditional and contemporary music that makes you want to dance. What a blessing for us here in the Diocese of the Central Gulf Coast to have that available to us.

Pick up a copy of ***Ten Ways to Pray***, and learn other ways to talk to God.


