Message From Thack

Caring for What God Has Entrusted to Us

For nearly every homeowner, there comes a time when the list of deferred maintenance items can no longer be ignored. Roofs must be repaired. Gutters replaced. Paint renewed. Water diverted away from foundations. None of these projects are particularly exciting, but all of them are necessary if the home is to remain safe, beautiful, and functional for years to come. The same is true for our parish.

Over the past several years, your Vestry has worked diligently to prioritize the most urgent needs of our campus. Rather than attempting to do everything at once, they have carefully directed our resources toward projects that demanded immediate attention. Most notably, they replaced the aging air-conditioning systems in both the church and the Howard Wilson Life Center. Those projects have now been completed and paid for, preserving the comfort and functionality of the spaces where we worship, learn, and gather.

In making those difficult decisions, however, several important maintenance projects were intentionally postponed. That was prudent stewardship. Your Vestry addressed the most pressing needs first while delaying work that, although important, could safely wait. The time has now come to address those remaining needs.

For that reason, the Vestry has approved a special Capital Campaign with a goal of raising **\$200,000, *over and above*** our annual General Fund and Building Fund giving. These funds will be dedicated exclusively to deferred maintenance projects that protect our buildings and preserve the campus God has entrusted to us.

Among the projects to be completed are:

- Redirecting stormwater that currently collects around the preschool and infiltrates the building.
- Repairing and replacing failing gutters.
- Brick and stucco repairs caused by water intrusion.
- Painting and repairing the church's round windows.
- Caulking and repainting windows in the Howard Wilson Life Center.
- Completing exterior paint touch-up after the brick and stucco repairs.
- Repairing deteriorating sections of the parking lot pavement.
- Installing new fiber-optic internet service throughout all church buildings.

- Installing lightning protection equipment to reduce our vulnerability to lightning strikes.
- Refinishing the gym floor in the Howard Wilson Life Center.
- Replacing the worn vinyl flooring and sagging ceiling tiles in McCann-Humphreys Hall.

In addition, we have already contracted for the replacement of the worn flooring in Malone Hall, including both the main meeting area and the office wing.

The total cost of these projects is approximately **\$200,000**. In the coming weeks, Matt Thomason, chair of the Capital Campaign committee, will provide a detailed itemized description of each project and its estimated cost.

It is important to understand that these are not improvements undertaken for appearance alone. They are investments in preserving our facilities and preventing far more costly repairs in the future. Deferred maintenance has a way of becoming emergency maintenance if ignored long enough.

As Christians, stewardship extends far beyond our financial giving. Stewardship is caring faithfully for everything God has placed in our hands. As David reminds us in Psalm 24, “The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it.” (Psalm 24:1)

Everything we possess ultimately belongs to God. We are not owners so much as caretakers, entrusted for a season with resources that are intended to serve God's mission.

Jesus teaches the same principle in the “Parable of the Talents,” (Matthew 25:14-30). The faithful servants are commended because they wisely managed what had been entrusted to them. Their stewardship reflected gratitude, responsibility, and faithfulness.

Likewise, St. Paul reminds us: “Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.” (1 Corinthians 4:2)

That verse has guided the Vestry throughout this process. Good stewardship requires discernment and good judgment. It means making wise decisions about priorities, resisting the temptation to spend simply because funds are available, and addressing the most urgent needs first. I believe your Vestry has exercised that responsibility faithfully. Now we are called to complete the work before us.

These buildings are more than bricks, wood, and concrete. They are places where children learn about Jesus, where families celebrate baptisms and weddings, where lives are nourished through worship and Christian formation, where grieving families are comforted, where neighbors find fellowship, and where our parish reaches out in Christ's name to the wider community.

The buildings themselves are not the Church. The people are the Church. Yet these facilities enable our ministry to flourish. Caring for them is one way we care for the generations who will worship here long after we are gone.

I invite you to pray about how God may be calling you to participate in this campaign. Together, as we have done so many times before, we can preserve this beautiful campus so that it continues to be a place where Christ is proclaimed, lives are transformed, and future generations encounter the love of God.

Thank you for your faithful stewardship, your generosity, and your love for Saint Paul's.

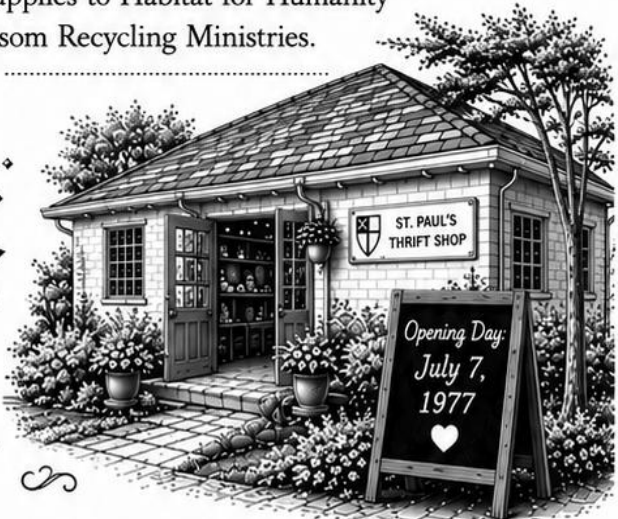

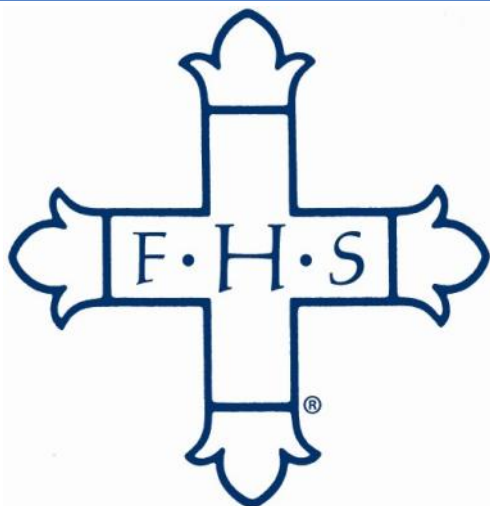

- Work to grow in our Christian faith and commitment through fellowship, prayer and Bible study.

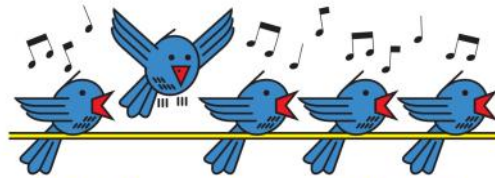
