



The annual Advocates for Children Ducky Derby is here again. The duck race will be held at Sam Smith Park in Cartersville, GA on May 11th from 10 - 2



The mission of Advocates for Children is to strengthen our community of families by offering safety, comfort and hope to children and preventing child abuse in all its forms. Advocates for Children provides

services and programs to children who have been the victims of abuse and neglect. We also offer multiple layers of personal care through an array of programs to reduce the incidence of child abuse. Advocates serves 17 Northwest Georgia counties offering Safety, Comfort and Hope to over 3,000 children and families every year.

Advocates for Children is offering an incentive to all seniors in Bartow County allowing them to earn money for college or other expenses. The senior who sells the most ducks is awarded \$5,000, 2nd place is \$2,500, and 3rd place is \$1,000.

Tickets sell for \$5.00 each; 6 for \$25.00; 13 for \$50.00; or the VID (Very Important Duck) package is \$250.00 (you get 50 ducks and an additional chance to win a \$1,000.)

The winner of the Duck Derby Race will win \$10,000!
