Please Vote in *U.S. News & World Report* Hospital Rankings

Voting has begun for the 2021 *U.S. News & World Report* “Best Hospitals” and “Best Children’s Hospitals” rankings. We encourage all Mount Sinai Health System physicians to support the increased rankings of all Health System hospitals.

The primary way for physicians to vote is via [Doximity.com](https://www.doximity.com), the largest online social networking service for physicians in the country. *U.S. News* ranks hospitals in 16 adult and 10 pediatric specialties. All physicians who are board certified in a ranked specialty and who claimed their Doximity profile before November 1, 2020, can vote in their specialty. Voting will be open through Friday, March 26, 2021.

Eligible physicians will receive a link to the ballot in their email and can access the survey through [Doximity.com](https://doximity.com) or the Doximity app for iPhone or Android. When voting, physicians will select hospitals from a dropdown list. For a full list of all Health System hospitals and how they will appear on Doximity, [click here](#). Physicians who did not register in time to vote on Doximity may still be eligible to receive a paper ballot. Ballots are mailed to a randomly selected sample of physicians. If you are voting by paper ballot, it is important to be very specific and use full, proper names with each entry. Write “Mount Sinai Beth Israel,” for instance, instead of simply “Mount Sinai,” or the entry might be attributed to The Mount Sinai Hospital. This is particularly important when you are asked to list up to five U.S. hospitals that provide the best inpatient care for challenging medical or surgical conditions in your specialty.
