Request for Ovarian Cancer Research Proposals

The Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Science and the Tisch Cancer Institute of Mount Sinai are dedicated to supporting innovative research to prevent, detect and cure ovarian cancer and to improve the lives of those living with ovarian cancer. With this RFA, we seek to support research focused on ovarian cancer. Basic science, translational, epidemiological, behavioral, health disparity and other research topics will be considered. This funding mechanism is designed to advance meritorious investigator-initiated hypothesis-driven research focused on ovarian cancer. Faculty members of the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai with concepts that are innovative are eligible.

Review Criteria: Proposals will be prioritized based on novelty, scientific quality, significance, impact and likelihood of leading to submission of future grant applications.

Proposal Requirements: Proposals should include:

- Background and specific aims
- Research strategy addressing significance, innovation, approach

Funding Guidelines: This award will offer a total direct cost of up to \$50,000 over 18 months (no extensions will be allowed). Allowable costs: salary and fringe benefits for research personnel, supplies. Unallowable costs: Investigator effort, travel, meals, consulting services. Term: 18 months (no extensions will be allowed).

Format and Submission Guidelines: Proposals should be submitted as a single PDF using single-spaced Arial 11-point font, 0.5" margins, and a maximum of two pages. All figures, diagrams or other materials should be inserted directly into the body of the proposal. In addition to the proposal, the application should include the following attachments (do not count toward page limit):

- References
- NIH Biosketch for the PI/Co-PI
- Budget and Budget Justification

Reporting Requirement:

A final report and presentation are required.
