

Policies and Procedures Addendum – Effective 2019-20 School Year

- Chapters with outstanding State or national fees – blocked from membership and conferences until resolved.
- All chapter dues must be paid by March 1st in order to be eligible to compete at SLC.
- Non-payment of conference fees – Invoices will be the sent day after the respective conference to school treasurers. For example:
 - If FLC unpaid – cannot sign up for Regional Competitive Events
 - If Regional unpaid – cannot sign up for ILC
 - If SLC and/or ILC unpaid – chapter blocked following year until payment received
- Purchase Order numbers will be requested at the time of registration
- No changes to competitions or additions after the event competition deadline unless approved by the state advisor.
- Parliamentary Procedure – regionals will be written exam only. State – both levels.
- All attendees shall register for conferences and wear the provided registration name badge.

Regional Competitive Events:

Advisors attending regional competitive events (at least 1 advisor per school) are expected to assist a limited amount of time with judging or other duties as agreed upon by the regional captain and/or state advisor.

Fall Leadership Conference

Advisors attending the Fall Leadership Conference may be expected to assist on a limited amount of time if requested and agreed upon by the state advisor.

State Leadership Conference

Advisors attending the State Leadership Conference (at least 1 advisor per school) are expected to assist on a limited amount of time with judging or other duties as agreed upon by the state advisor.

International Leadership Conference

Advisors attending the ILC are expected to assist limited amount of time with judging or other duties as agreed upon by the state advisor.

Changes in Recognition Category

Chapters participating in the Recognition Category will receive their recognition at an Evening Recognition Awards session at the SLC. Students receiving recognition in HOSA Happenings, the National Service Project, and Barbara James Service Award will be eligible to attend the ILC. Each student, if they are not competing in a competitive event at the ILC, will be assigned by the state advisor, in conjunction with the local advisor, to serve on the courtesy corps; as a workshop ambassador; or as a helper with the National HOSA competitive events assigned to Ohio. In addition, the students must sign up for at least two workshops.

Students who qualify in a competitive event at the SLC or who place with a score of 75% or higher in the Healthcare Issues Exam will be able to advance to the ILC.
