Re: Cleveland Cavs – Ohio HAS Educational Event

Thank you for your participation in the Cavs event! Below are some important details.

- We are working in collaboration with the Cavs, Fox Sports Channel, the Miami Heat and many other folks.
- We have been working continuously with many partners to add a new educational experience for you and your students.
- All students attending the Stop the Bleed training must view the following websites PRIOR to attending the event. Regarding the website with the training video, this is the link: <https://stopthebleed.usuhs.edu/> Please advise your teachers that the students should spend **15 minutes** watching the video, doing the Q&A, and generally interacting with the website within about 48hrs of the event. You may forward the link and those directions; I think that's probably simplest.

Schedule for November 14th.

- a. Buses should arrive by 12:15 PM.
- b. Buses should drop off students at the corner of Ontario and Huron Streets.
- c. Students must go through security as they enter Rocket Mortgage Fieldhouse at the Sherwin Williams Entrance at this location.
- d. Detailed agenda below:

1:00 – 1:30 PM Registration of chapters and pick up your tee shirts.

1:30 – 2:00 PM – Presentation by MTKYN Foundation and American Heart Association (All 600+) will occur in the Atrium. Note: There will be seating for 200 and the others will be standing in that area for the presentation. **Please prepare your students to be ready to potentially stand for parts of the program.**

1:30 – 2:00 PM All adults will be trained by the Stop the Bleed program. ***It is criteria that we have 30 trainers in order to get all 600 plus students credentialed.***

3 – Rotational Sessions (Anatomage, Donate Life, Stop The Bleed)

2:00 – 2:30 PM and

2:35 – 3:05 PM and

3:10 – 3:40 PM (Rotational sessions)

The students will be divided into three groups by school to the best of our ability) and rotate to each of the three following programs:

- A. Stop the Bleed Training
- B. Anatomage Table Presentation
- C. Donate Life Presentation

3:45 PM – All attendees must exit Rocket Mortgage Fieldhouse (NBA rules). Chapters may go to Tower City for dinner or elsewhere.

4:30 PM Chapters may re-enter Rocket Mortgage Fieldhouse to purchase food from vendors and/or go to your seat location.

5:15 PM – Shoot Around open to ALL attendees, not just HOSA.

At 5:00 PM – the students you selected as identified below MUST meet at the M116 section in order to go onto the court.

5:15 PM – Each chapter may have 1 attendee to go onto the court for the High Five (Greet Miami and Cavs players onto the court). **

5:15 PM – Each chapter may have 1 attendee to go onto the court for Center Court recognition. **

6:15 PM – Enjoy the game. Go Cavs!

****Special Details**

1. ***Because of security and NBA rules, we will need to go through security twice.*** Once when we arrive for the educational program and again when we re-enter after 4:30PM.
2. Students should not bring bags, knives, vaping, smoking items along with other items that typically will hold up the security screening.
3. Students must be dressed in school appropriate clothing – no jeans with holes.
4. ***Students going on the court must wear clothing with no holes, tennis shoes, provided tee shirt, no hats or jackets.***
