

## Saint Aloysius Church 2020 Mass Intention Request

Due to the great number of requests for announced Masses and an increased number of parishioners, we are accepting Mass Intention requests *only* through the use of this request form. Each **family** is limited to “**2**” (**two**) Mass Intentions per year.

- If the exact time and date you requested is not available, the closest available Mass time and date will be assigned. Please indicate which is more important—date or time.
- All requests must be accompanied by the proper stipend for each Mass requested. (Checks payable to: St. Aloysius Church)
- We CANNOT take any requests by telephone or in person unless the person is recently deceased.
- Please enclose a self-addressed STAMPED envelope or provide an email address so that we may notify you of the days and times assigned.
- We regret that once the Mass book is filled, we cannot accommodate any additional requests. Any request we cannot honor will be returned along with the stipend. However, the Annual Enrollment and Masses said at St. Paul’s Seminary will always be available.

Sanctuary Devotional Lamp Blessed Mother Devotional Lamp Holy Family Devotional Lamp <b>\$25</b>	The lamp will burn for one week for your intention
Nursing Home Mass <b>\$15</b>	First & fourth Tuesday of the Month at 2:30 p.m.
Altar Bread & Wine: <b>\$50</b>	Remember a loved one with the gift of Altar Bread & Wine for one week
