The Office of Victim Advocate is encouraging high school students across the Commonwealth to compete in a poster challenge to celebrate National Crime Victims' Rights Week. The theme this year is KINSHIP; Connecting & Healing. KINSHIP is a call to action to recognize that shared humanity should be at the center of supporting all survivors and victims of crime. This activity is meant to provide an opportunity to discuss the impact of crime on victims and how we can support crime victims in KINSHIP and increase access to services, rights, and healing.

**All submissions must be received by March 28.** Select posters will be displayed in the PA State Capitol from April 9-11, 2025.

The Rules:

- Each poster must be developed and completed by a student
- All concepts should be based on this year's theme: KINSHIP; Connecting & Healing
- Only ONE poster may be submitted per student
- The maximum accepted size is equivalent to a 22"x28" poster board
- You must include a submission entry form with your poster for consideration
