MEET THE PASTORS



The Rev. Bruce Dillman

Pastor Bruce began his career in ministry as a Roman Catholic priest, ordained for the Archdiocese of Louisville. Upon leaving active ministry in 1986, he went to work first for the Internal Revenue Service as a tax auditor, then for two public accounting firms, and later as a high school math teacher for Jefferson County Public Schools. He returned to ministry and became a part of Hope's staff in 2018.



The Rev. Dr. Dean Piper

Pastor Dean earned a BA from Capital University, and an M.Div and D.Min from Trinity Seminary in Ohio. His Doctor of Ministry is in New Testament theology with a concentration in Apocalyptic Literature. He has three published works, two of which are on The Book of Revelation.

In addition to his ministry, Pastor Piper has also been an adjunct professor at both Capital University and Trinity Seminary.

THE FREEDOM OF A CHRISTIAN WITH PASTOR BRUCE

Last year (2020) marked the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther's treatise which he called "The Freedom of a Christian." To mark this milestone, Elizabeth Eaton, ELCA presiding bishop, asked that resources be developed for study of this document, inviting the church to "hear, share and experience the Lutheran witness of the Christian faith as it relates to God's narrative of freedom in Christ."

Pastor Bruce will use these resources, as well as the treatise "The Freedom of a Christian, 1520: The Annotated Luther Study Edition by Timothy J. Wengert (Fortress Press, 2016) for an intensive study of this document this Fall and next Spring. Participants in this 12-week class will be offered a chance to purchase the book at a discounted rate soon.

We will be studying this document in for 7 weeks in November and December 2021, and an additional 5 weeks in the Spring. Stay tuned to Digital News in the Pews for class specifics as well as information about ordering the book.
