- The demand at the Lake Weir Food Pantry is great – 70 additional bags had to be filled to meet the need. Stephen Ministers have been there on Thursdays for support and prayer.
- Faith and Fellowship to expand. Hope Central continues every Monday at 9:30am. New: Lake Weir 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays, Hope South 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Mondays. *(Thank you Pastor Rani)*
