## Market Alerts

**Limes** – Due to extended dry conditions in Mexico's Lime growing regions, supplies have tightened. Pricing is expected to remain higher than normal for several weeks.

**Broccoli** – Recent heat in Salinas Valley CA has shortened supplies. Quality is fair; pricing is higher than normal on Crowns and Florets.

**Potatoes** – The storage crop for **Idaho bakers** is coming to an end over the next few weeks. Pricing is higher on most sizes, with **90 CT and smaller** being the best value.

**Apples** – The storage crop is coming to an end, with **Granny Smith** and **Golden Delicious** less available. Consider substituting with other varieties.

**Locally Grown** – The local growing season continues through autumn. **Check out our locally-source list for availability.**

**Green Bell Peppers** – Excellent quality and pricing.

**Pears** – Quality and pricing are great on Bartlett and Asian varieties.

**Grapes** – California continues to harvest quality product, with excellent texture and sugar levels.

**Summer Squash** – Quality and pricing are excellent.

**Colored Potatoes** – All colors and Fingerling varieties are excellent quality.

**Stone Fruit** – End of season Peaches and Plums are very nice quality. **Jersey Nectarines** have finished.
