

Catholic Trivia Answers:

1. Of the 6.3 billion people in the world, **more than a billion are Catholics**. Altogether, there are two billion Christians.
2. They are **Reconciliation** (confession if possible or a general absolution), **Anointing of the Sick** (with commendation for the dying), the **Eucharist** if still conscious (Holy Communion for the dying is called Viaticum).
3. Nazareth (Nazarene). INRI stands for Jesus the Nazarene, King of the Jews (*Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum* in Latin).
4. It is widely believed that the Acts of the Apostles was written by the same author as the third gospel, who is known as St. Luke.
5. According to popular tradition, St. Patrick used a shamrock as a simple analogy to explain the mystery of the Trinity to the pagan chieftains of Ireland. The shamrock is one but has three leaves.
