

Catholic Trivia 5-28 Answers:

1. There are two stories of creation. **Genesis 1:1-2:4** and **Genesis 2:4-10**.
2. “Though the work of creation is attributed to the Father in particular, it is equally a truth of faith that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit together are the one, indivisible principle of creation.” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* 316)
3. God has revealed it to us. As the Catechism says: The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.” (CCC 261)
4. NO! Jesus is fully human and fully divine. Referring to the Catechism again: The unique and altogether singular event of the Incarnation of the Son of God does not mean that Jesus Christ is part God and part man, nor does it imply that he is the result of a confused mixture of the divine and the human. He became truly man while remaining truly God. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. (CCC 464)
