- 1. **Seven.** There are three Archangels that are named in Scripture: Gabriel, Raphael and Michael. They are currently the only three who are officially recognized by name in Catholic doctrine. The names of the other four Archangels appear in Jewish and Christian sources outside of the canon of Sacred Scripture (for example, the Book of Enoch chapter 20) and their names are: Uriel, Raguel, Zerachiel, and Remiel.
- 2. The bread used for the celebration of the Eucharist is to be unleavened (without yeast or other leaveners) and made from wheat.
- 3. All of the apostles commissioned by Jesus were Jewish.
- 4. Nazareth in Galilee.
- 5. The bishop of the diocese is Most Rev. Robert W. McElroy. His two auxiliary bishops are Most Rev. John P. Dolan and Most Rev. Ramon Bejarano (just recently ordained a bishop).
