1. To be a Doctor of the Catholic Church is an official title given to a saint by the Pope or a Church council, recognizing their outstanding holiness and significant contribution to the Church's theology and doctrine through their writings and teachings. These individuals are considered models of faith, and their body of work offers deep spiritual and intellectual enlightenment and serves as a timeless resource for understanding Catholic Tradition.
2. Four women have been named Doctors of the Church.
3. The four women Doctors of the Catholic Church are Saint Teresa of Ávila, Saint Catherine of Siena, Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, and Saint Hildegard of Bingen.
4. There are 34 male Doctors of the Church out of the 38 recognized by the Catholic Church.
5. The most recent saint designated as a Doctor of the Church is St. John Henry Newman, with Pope Leo XIV approving the title on July 31, 2025. This designation acknowledges Newman's profound theological insights and his influential writings on the development of doctrine and the role of conscience.
